Call to Order 4:30 p.m.

1. **Welcome** by Brien Maxfield.
2. **Minutes from previous meeting (March 16) approved via email.** There are sixteen voting members. Ten approved the minutes, six gave no response.
3. **2016-2017 Trust Lands Proposal review and vote.** Bryan Leggat handed out copies of the proposal. Bryan Leggat, Cynthia Vander Meiden, and Aaron Hunter took turns explaining the different parts of the proposal. Opportunities for were given for questions and discussion. A vote was held. Of the sixteen voting members of the council, eleven were present. All voted unanimously to accept the proposal. Members of the council will receive an e-mail with instructions on providing their electronic signatures.
4. **Celebrations and Latest News.** Bryan Leggat explained about the assembly held last week featuring Dennard Mitchell. There has been a lot of positive feedback from the students.
5. **Counseling Report.** Looking at hiring one full-time and one part-time counselor for next year. The interviewing process will start next week.

6. **Summary on Vending Machines.** The school has been holding a fundraiser selling sugared items during lunch to earn money for an electronic marquee. This has been the first year the school has been without a vending machine offering these kinds of items. A question was asked about how much money has been earned, and if more money is coming in with this fundraiser or from the vending machines. So far the school has made about \$750. They made more money off vending machines in previous years.
7. **Discussion on getting more parent involvement and diverse representation on the community council.** Ideas were discussed including involving parents of students involved in leadership groups, talking to the ESL aide, making personal invitations, posters and sign-up sheets during Back to School Night. Bryan Leggat will work with Mr. Larsen (LIA Advisor) and come up with a plan for next year.
