Called to Order 4:30 p.m.

1. **Minutes from previous meeting approved via email.** There are eighteen voting members of the council; twelve approved the minutes and six abstained.
2. **Welcome.** Meeting was held in the main office instead of the media center.
3. **Celebrations, Latest News**
  - a. It was awesome to have the governor visit. Bryan Leggat explained how we got this opportunity.
  - b. The STEM students are working hard and will have their STEM Night on April 22, 2015 and Elk Ridge Middle School to show case their projects.
  - c. Remodeling of the KIVA will start on April 21<sup>st</sup>. Bryan Leggat explained the KIVA changes.
  - d. No one will be allowed at the school this summer during construction. Summer Math and Reading will be held at West Jordan High. We will be losing one of the portables next year, all classrooms will be emptied during construction and some teachers will be in different rooms next year in order to have departments in same location. Moving will happen the last week of school.

4. **Counseling.** Counselors are getting ready for next year. Joyce Linder gave report on the Ninth Grade College Tour. Would like to do more tours next year to allow more students the opportunity.
5. **Accreditation.** Cynthia Vander Meiden reported on Accreditation. The school passed with an overall above average score. Improvement priority given to improve Tier 1 instruction. This would involve more administration classroom observations and assigned needed professional development. An improvement suggestion was given to use data and train teachers to use data to help with Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction. The next accreditation will be in five years.
6. **2015-2016 Trustlands proposal review and vote.** Bryan Leggat reviewed the Trustlands proposal and four goals for the next year. Goals include: 1) Funding for Counseling Center so can have a full-time counselor and programs to improve Plans for College and Career Readiness; 2) Funding to continue ZAP program and learning lab aids; 3) Funding for teacher professional development; and 4) Funding to increase access to technology. Discussion was held on each area of the proposal. **MOTION:** Brenda Montgomery moved to approve the 2015-2016 Trustlands proposal. It was seconded. There are 18 voting members of the council; 12 were present and approved the proposal. An e-mail requesting electronic signatures to verify council membership and participation was sent to community council members.

8. **Opportunity for Community comments.**
  - a. Two new teachers have been hired: Heather Woffinden for CTE Business and Nicole Morris for Science.
  - b. The school still needs to hire a part-time Language Arts teacher with an ESL endorsement; and a 17-hour academic tracker.
  - c. Parents requested receiving more information about school events such as food drives, Internet Safety Assemblies, etc.
